Accessibility/particulars

Public transport

The Rode Hoed is in the center of Amsterdam, a 10-minute walk from Central Station. Due to its central location, the Rode Hoed is easily accessible by public transport. Public transport offers various possibilities: the second stop from Central Station, Nieuwezijds Kolk stop, tram 1,2,5,13 and 17. Tram 13 and 17 also stop at Westermarkt.

Own transportation

> From The Hague

Take the A4 towards Amsterdam. At the Amsterdam take the A10 in direction of Zaanstad. Then, take exit S103 in the direction of Haarlem. At the end, turn right towards the center, Haarlemmerweg. Continue along the road, via Haarlemmerplein, in the direction of Central Station.

> From Amersfoort

Take the A1 towards Amsterdam. At Amsterdam take the Ring Amsterdam Oost in the direction of Zaandam. Then, take exit S114 in the direction of Artis. At the end, turn left towards the center, through the Piet-Hein tunnel, in the direction of Central Station. *See general description for further information*

> From Utrecht

Take the A1 towards Amsterdam. At Amsterdam, take the Ring Amsterdam Oost in the direction of Zaandam. Then, exit S114 in the direction of Artis. At the end turn left towards the center, through Piet Hein Tunnel, in the direction of Central Station. *See general description for further information*

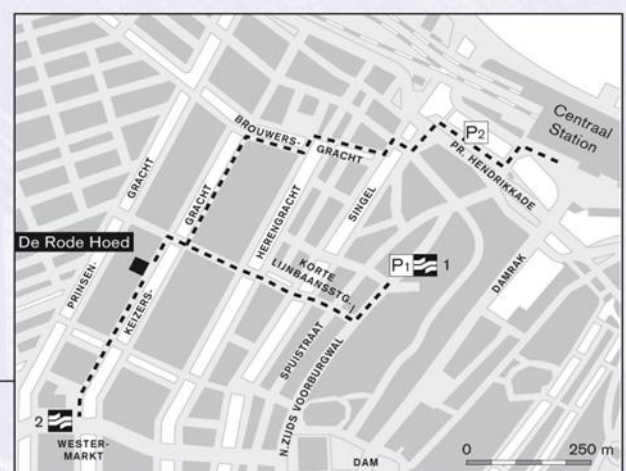
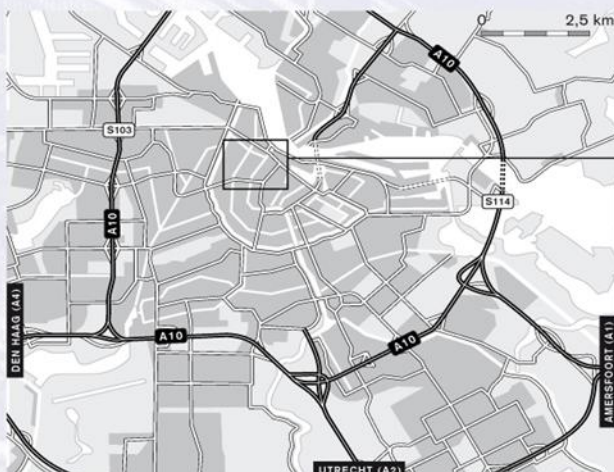
General description Amersfoort / Utrecht

After the Piet-Hein tunnel right into the Piet-Hein kade, after that, follow the road in the direction of Central Station

ACCESSIBILITY / PARTICULARS

Parking | The parking garages De Kolk on the Nieuwezijds Voorburgwal and the ANWB parking garage at the Central Station are within walking distance of De Rode Hoed. The route is drawn on the map.

Loading and unloading | A loading bay is located opposite the entrance.



Jetty | De Rode Hoed has its own jetty and is therefore also easily accessible by (round-trip) boat or water taxi.

Disabled persons | Only the Grote Zaal is accessible for wheelchairs. A toilet for disabled persons is located on the ground floor.

People with a hearing disability | A closed circuit has been installed in the Grote Zaal (Ampetronic, Induction driver (ILDG)).
