Registration is now open for the upcoming "2nd LOFAR Users Meeting" and the "2015 LOFAR Community Science Workshop" to be held June 1-3, 2015.

The International LOFAR Telescope (ILT) consortium will host a meeting and a workshop for the LOFAR community from June 1-3, 2015 in Assen, The Netherlands. The events will begin on Monday afternoon, June 1, with the 2nd LOFAR Users Meeting. This meeting is open to the whole LOFAR community and is organized by the Radio Observatory to provide a forum for users to both learn about the status of the array as well as give feedback. Following the Users Meeting, the 2015 LOFAR Community Science workshop will kick off on Tuesday morning, June 2 and will run through the end of the day on Wednesday, June 3. The two events are naturally related. The Users Meeting will set the scene for the Science Workshop, by discussing the operational status of LOFAR, technical developments, and software enhancements. Participants are therefore encouraged to attend both events. One registration fee is applied.
