The International LOFAR Telescope (ILT) consortium will host workshops for the LOFAR community from 20-23 May 2019 in Leiden, the Netherlands.

The events will begin on Monday 20 May at 11 am with the 2019 LOFAR Users Meeting. This meeting is aimed at a wide-ranging dialogue with the full LOFAR community, and will bring together members of the Key Science Projects (KSPs), researchers with approved LOFAR projects, as well as any potential LOFAR users. It will provide a forum to both learn about the status of the array as well as to give feedback.

Following the Users Meeting, the 2019 LOFAR Community Science Workshop will kick off on Tuesday morning 21 May, and will run through until the end of the day on Wednesday, 22 May. It will feature a wide range of talks on exciting new scientific results from the Cycle observing programmes. Special emphasis will be given in the programme to younger members of the collaboration to give them a chance to showcase their results.

On Thursday 23 May, the *LOFAR 2.0 discussion* will take place. During this event, the plans for the LOFAR upgrade will be presented and discussed in detail. The discussion will conclude at lunch time.
