The DRAGNET project extends the detection and localization capabilities for pulsars and fast radio transients by LOFAR.

It started on Jan 1st, 2014 and has a duration of 5 years.

It is funded by an NWO VIDI and an ERC Starting Grant. There is also some funding from NOVA.

- WP3: Neutron star monitoring
- WP4: Characterizing the transient radio sky
- WP5: Understanding neutron star magnetospheres
