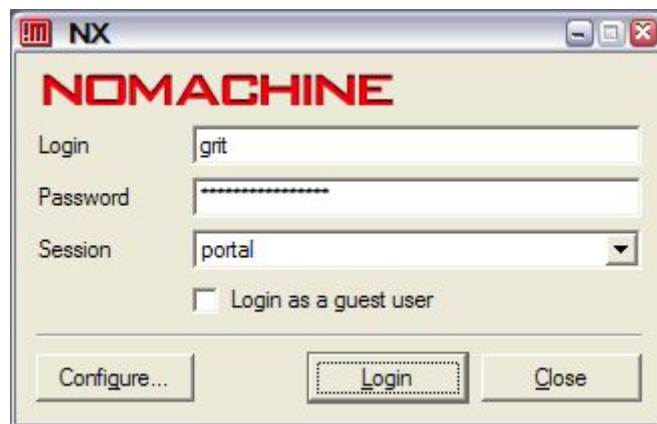


Free NX usage

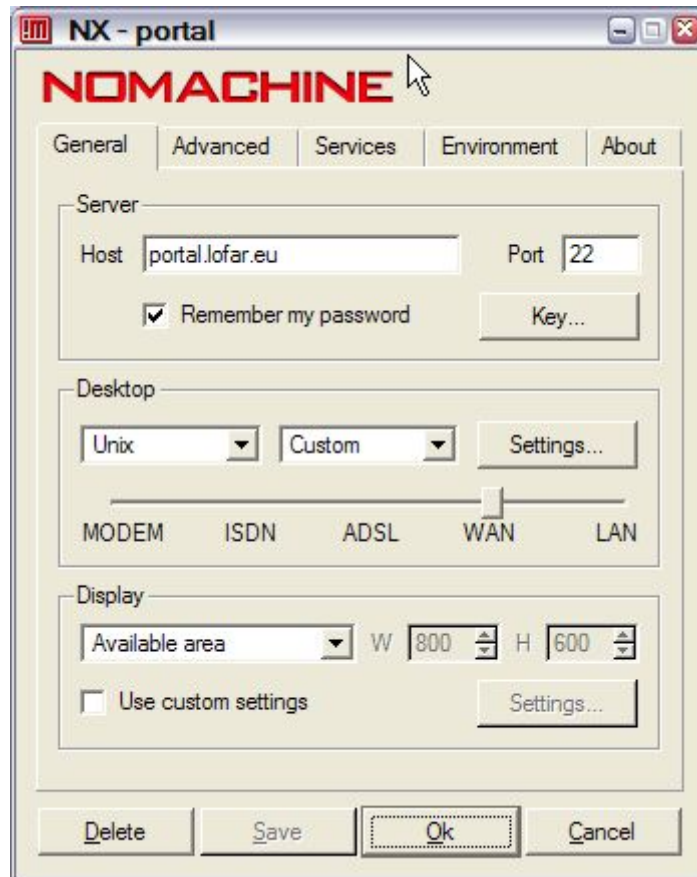
The FreeNX facility is an open-source client-server application for X11 compression. It offers you an X11 login environment on your local machine (e.g. laptop) with the look and feel as if you are working locally on your remote server. Windows client configuration

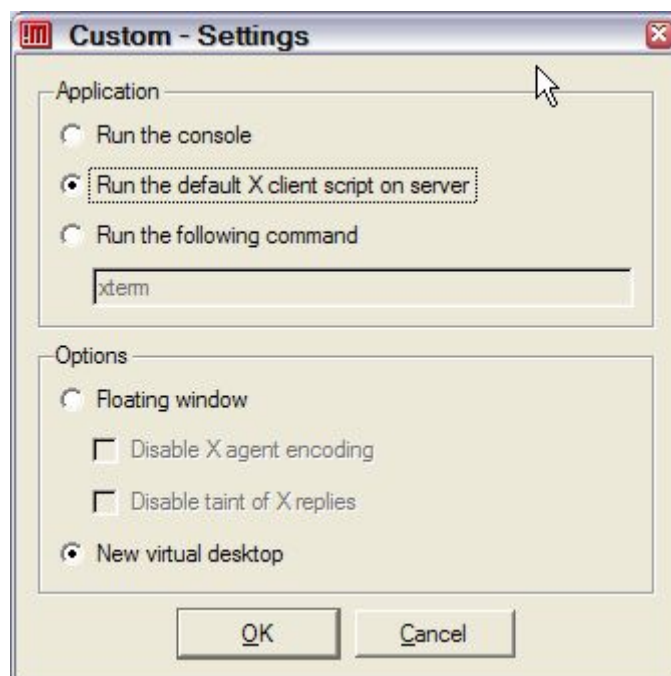
Once installed on your Windows PC or laptop, you can start the NX Client for Windows:
